POLICY:

Approval of the optional Polo Shirt (at the employee's expense) for use by Training and Safety Bureau and other training cadre personnel both career and volunteer while instructing the below hands on type training courses.

PROCEDURE:

Career employees serving as cadre instructors have the option to wear the approved Polo Shirt. The career employee Polo Shirt would be embroidered with the CAL FIRE logo as outlined in CAL FIRE Uniform Purchasing Guide 1500, Exhibit A.

Volunteer firefighters serving as cadre instructors also have the option to wear the approved Polo Shirt. The volunteer firefighter approved Polo shirt would be embroidered with the Butte County Fire Department logo as outlined in the Volunteer SOP manual.

Polo shirts are approved to be worn during the below training courses and applications.

- Low angle Rope Rescue Operations
- Rescue Systems 1
- Rescue Systems 2
- Pump Operations
- Emergency Vehicle Operations Course
- Truck Academy
- RIC
- FSTEP Firefighter Survival
- Firefighter Safety and Survival
- EMS courses
- Technical Rescue Drills
- Auto Extrication 1, 2, 3
- Other hands on type training

Under no circumstances will the approved Polo Shirt be worn on emergency incidents or under required PPE.

All uniform garments must be clean and in good condition per CAL FIRE policy.
